Into our soul and body and heart, now flow the river of life






- John sees in revelation, the river flowing down the main street, flowing from the temple, where this water flows everything will live. We are trees planted by the water.
- John says anyone who believes and receives Christ Jesus, the river will flow from the heart, replenishing and restoring and renewing life. New life will flourish


We are now to be outposts of the very presence of God.
